December 10 The Blessed Virgin Mary of Loreto

Texts for Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours, Lectionary Entry

On October 7, 2019, Pope Francis ordered the inscription of Our Lady of Loreto into the General Roman Calendar. She is to be celebrated each year as an optional Memorial on December 10 (the day her feast is celebrated in Loreto).

The proper liturgical texts were released by the Holy See in Latin. An English translation must be prepared by the International Commission on English in the Liturgy, approved by the USCCB, and sent to the Holy See for the requisite confirmation. Once confirmation is received, the translation will be publicly released and implemented in the United States. (A similar approval and confirmation process is required for a Spanish translation as well.)

However, the Collect for the new celebration is identical to one already found in the *Roman Missal*, in the Common of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent. If the BVM of Loreto is celebrated, the rest of the formulary – Prayer over the Offerings, Preface, Prayer after Communion, and Entrance and Communion Antiphons – can be drawn from the same Mass formulary as the Collect. White vestments are worn.

Aside from the usual Mass readings of the day, any Lectionary readings from the Common of the Blessed Virgin Mary may be used for the Blessed Virgin Mary of Loreto. The following readings are also recommended by the Holy See (with citations from nos. 707-712 of the *Lectionary for Mass*):

FIRST READING

Isaiah 7:10-14; 8:10 [no. 707.7]

The virgin shall conceive and bear a son.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM

Luke 1:46-47, 48-49, 50-51, 52-53, 54-55 [no. 709.5]

R. The Almighty has done great things for me, and holy is his Name.

OR

R. O Blessed Virgin Mary, you carried the Son of the eternal Father.

ALLELUIA

See Luke 1:28 [no. 711.1]

R. Alleluia, alleluia.

Hail, Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you;
blessed are you among women.

R. Alleluia, alleluia.

GOSPEL

Luke 1:26-38 [no. 712.4]

Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son.
