#### Day 1 Friday, October 14: Depart for Turkey

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport via Turkish Airlines for the overnight transatlantic flight to Istanbul. Dinner, breakfast, and beverages will be served on board. (D)

# Day 2 Saturday, October 15: Arrive in Istanbul

Arrive at Istanbul International Airport, go through Customs, claim our luggage and meet a Peter's Way tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable motor coach and we will be on our way to Istanbul. Istanbul's blend of Eastern and Western culture has resulted in some of the most magnificent architecture in the world. Check-in at our hotel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Istanbul.

## Day 3 Sunday, October 16: Highlights of Istanbul

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with Mass at the Church of St. Anthony. Today, we will explore the monuments of Istanbul, which had once been the capital of the Byzantine and then the Ottoman Empire. We will visit Hippodrome Square, the former center of sports and political activities of Constantinople. See the Obelisk, the Serpentine Column from Delphi, and fountain of Wilhelm II. Then, enter the Blue Mosque. This 16th century edifice is famous for its tiles made by the masters of Nicea. This is the most famous monument in both the Turkish and Islamic world; it is the only mosque built with six minarets, decorated with famous Izmir tiles. Then, make our way to the first monumental church of the Byzantines, Hagia Sophia. Its dome rests at a height of 182 feet and will embrace your soul with its grandeur. Built by Constantine in the 4th century, it was reconstructed by Justinian in the 6th century. Today, it is a magnificent monument representing the influence of two religions: Christianity and Islam. Visit the Underground Cisterns. Independent lunch.

Visit Imperial Topkapi Palace, residence of Ottoman Sultans between the 15th and 19th centuries. The palace is known for its display of the royal treasures, including the legendary Spoonmaker's Diamond. We will be guided through this oriental palace and view the world's richest porcelain collection of the Ming Dynasty of China. Then, proceed to the Grand Bazaar, one of the most interesting and irresistible attractions of Istanbul. (B,D)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Istanbul.

# Day 4 Monday, October 17: Highlights of Thessaloniki

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we will be transferred to Istanbul Airport for our continuing flight to Thessaloniki. Late morning, we'll arrive in Thessaloniki International Airport, go through Customs, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager as we exit baggage claim. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way to Thessaloniki for our orientation tour. Thessaloniki is the second largest city in Greece and the capital of Macedonia, where Paul preached and founded a church. Celebrate Mass at Immaculate Conception Cathedral. It is also called the Temple of the Immaculate Conception, representing an entirely different style and philosopy in a city dominated by Paleo-Christian masterpieces. The main characteristic of the building is the three-isled basilica, along with the semi-dome that leads to the side arches of the structure. Stylistically, it follows Renaissance standards, while its architectural influences can be found in European countries, especially France. Rows of Corinthian-style columns welcome all those who enter. At the center of the altar (Holy Temple) lies the Virgin Mary's figure, while the statue of Paul the Apostle will definitely draw your attention. After our visit, check-in at our hotel and enjoy a free afternoon to rest or explore Thessaloniki on your own.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Thessaloniki.

## Day 5 Tuesday, October 18: Thessaloniki | Kavala | Philippi

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a tour of Thessaloniki. The New Testament books of Thessalonians are St. Paul's correspondence with the people of this church. See the ramparts of the city; the triumphal Arch of Galerius starting the Via Egnatia, once a strategic artery of the Roman Empire; and the Roman Agora where Paul preached. Visit St. Demetrios Church with its valuable mosaics and frescoes, then drive to the upper town, which offers a marvelous view of the city. After our visit, continue on to Kavala (the ancient Neapolis) where Paul, Timothy, and Silas landed on the coast of Thrace. Then, visit Philippi, where Paul won his first European convert, a woman named Lydia from the city of Thyatira. Tour the Baptistery of Lydia, the market place where Paul and Silas were brought before the rulers, and the cistern that tradition identifies as the place where Paul was imprisoned. Celebrate Mass at the Baptistery of Lydia.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Thessaloniki. (B.D)

#### Day 6 Wednesday, October 19: Veria | Meteora

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Thessaloniki to visit Veria (ancient Beria) to see the memorial commemorating Paul's preaching to the local Jews in 54 AD. Part of the Roman road, the Egnatia Way, is still visible today in Veria today. Celebrate Mass at the Bema in Veria. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, continue to the area of Kalambaka for an amazing view of the monastaries with dozens of rock pillars jutting up out of the plain. Christian hermits lived in the caves in these rocks beginning in 985 and then, beginning in the 14th century, monasteries were founded and built on top of many of these towers. The region is known as Meteora, Greek for "suspended." These "monasteries hanging in the air" are a major center of Eastern Orthodox spirituality. We will visit one of the six monasteries that are still active. (B.D)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Kalambaka.

#### Day 7 Thursday, October 20: Athens

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we will leave Kalambaka for Athens. Independent lunch upon arrival.

After lunch, we will explore the most famous sites in Greece: the Athens Acropolis and famed Parthenon. Visit Mars Hill, where Paul addressed the counselors and philosophers of the Areopagus. Continue our Athens orientation tour, passing by the Olympic Stadium of 1896, Temple of Zeus, Royal Palace, Syndagma Square, Memorial to the Unknown Soldiers, Arch of Hadrian, Hadrian's Wall, the Olympic Complex of 2004 Games, and the Academy University National Library. Celebrate Mass at St. Dennis Church. Check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Athens.

#### Day 8 Friday, October 21: Aegean Greek Islands Cruise | Mykonos | Sail to Kusadasi

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we will be transferred to St. Paul Church in Piraeus for morning Mass. After Mass, we will travel to Piraeus Harbor in time for the 11:30 a.m. boarding of the cruise ship Celestyal Olympia. Lunch on board is included.

Arrive in Mykonos, a paradise island known for its nightlife, beautiful beaches, boutiques, and cuisine. This Greek island has hundreds of tiny chapels dotting the landscape and sheep grazing in the shadow of white washed windmills. While on Mykonos, you are free to explore on your own.

Dinner and overnight aboard Celestyal Olympia.

#### Day 9 Saturday, October 22: Cruise to Kusadasi | Patmos | Overnight Sail to Crete

Arrive in Kusadasi. Disembark and travel by bus to Ephesus, the best preserved of the Seven Churches of Revelation (Rev. 2.1-7). St. Paul made Ephesus his headquarters for over two years and wrote his First Letter to the Corinthians from here. Later in the first century, St. John ministered here for many years. We will visit the ancient city with its impressive temples, marble streets, library, agoras, baths, and theater that seats 24,000 people. We will also visit the House of the Virgin Mary. One tradition says this is the place where St. John brought Mary after the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. A small house was built for her on Bulbuldagi (Mount Nightingale), where she spent the last days of her earthly life. Visit the beautiful chapel Panaya Kapula, also known as "The House of the Virgin Mary," built on the Mount Setimisses. Pope Benedict XVI celebrated Mass here in 2006, as did Pope Paul VI and St. John Paul II before him. Celebrate Mass at the House of the Virgin Mary.

Sail to Patmos. Arrive near the island of Patmos and transfer by boat to the "Holy Island," known as the site of the apocalyptic Revelation of John, written here during his exile from the Roman Empire. The cave where St. John lived is near the site of the Monastery of the Apocalypse. Visit the Monastery of St. John, built on one of the island's highest points, which houses priceless icons.

All meals and overnight aboard Celestyal Olympia.

#### Day 10 Sunday, October 23: Heraklion (Crete) | Santorini | **Overnight Sail to Piraeus**

Arrive in Heraklion, the capital of Crete and its principal commercial port. Travel to the nearby fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. Discovered in 1899 by Sir Arthur Evans, this elaborate palace was the seat of ancient Minoan culture, which flourished in the 18th century B.C. After visiting the site we will return to Heraklion.

Afternoon sail to Santorini. Arrive in Santorini, the island that some believe to be the site of the lost city of Atlantis. (Optional excursion on Santorini is not included). Spend free time in the village of Fira, perched on the rim of a crater formed by a volcano that destroyed the island around 1630 B.C. Take a cable car to the top or ride a donkey up a zigzag path. There are many interesting shops, and it is easy to find a cafe or taverna that has a spectacular view. Celebrate Mass on board the cruise ship. This evening, we'll sail overnight to Piraeus Harbor in Athens.

All meals and overnight aboard Celestyal Olympia.

## Day 11 Monday, October 24: Piraeus | Corinth | Athens

Dock at Piraeus. After an early breakfast, disembark and begin our day with an excursion to Corinth (Acts 18.1-18). Stop briefly en route to see the Corinth Canal, the famous man-made construction named one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. Continue to Corinth, where St. Paul wrote the First Letter to the Thessalonians and, most likely, his Letter to the Romans. Explore the extensive archeological site, including the Temple of Apollo, the Roman Agora, and the Bema, where Paul's enemies brought him before Gallo. See the pavement inscription of Erastus, the Roman Lechaion Road, the lower Fountain of Peirene, and the imposing Acrocorinth, an 1,800-foot hill that rises high above the ancient city. Here, in the first century, there were a large number of shrines and temples dominated by the Temple of Aphrodite. It was also the location of a series of fortifications built during ancient and medieval times that continued through the successive chain of Franco, Byzantine, Venetian, and Turkish supremacy. Celebrate Mass outdoors in Corinth. Independent lunch.

After lunch, we'll continue to Athens for hotel check-in. Early evening, we will visit the Plaka, a lively historic neighborhood nestled at the foot of the Acropolis. Feast on local cuisine and enjoy fine wine in a traditional tayerna while Greek entertainment creates a wonderful ambiance around us.
