[NEW FOR 2026 – 2027 School Year:](#)

[Beginning with the 2026-2027 School Year, Reitz Memorial will move to trimester, a four-and-a-half-day academic school week. Classes Monday-Thursday will run from 7:30AM – 2:50PM, with five classes and LINK \(previously our homeroom period\) each day. Classes are 70 minutes, and LINK is 35 minutes. Teachers have four classes and one plan each day.](#)

[Fridays will be shortened, with school beginning at 7:30AM and ending at 11:40AM. All five classes will be 35 minutes in length, with a 50-minute homeroom. This is the first year of our shift to move](#)

towards a formational experience on Fridays, with this being year 0. Each subsequent year we will build out formational experiences for our students and staff on specific Fridays, to support their wholistic formation.

Summary:

Reitz Memorial High School is accepting applications for a full-time Math position for the 2026-2027 academic year. The ideal candidate will be able to teach all levels of Math in grades 9-12 and must hold or be eligible to obtain a valid Indiana Teaching License. Willingness to obtain dual credit certification status, either through AP or 18 hours of Master's level coursework in their content field, is expected.

Essential Job Functions:

- Ensure students achieve learning outcomes in the subject of Mathematics by instructing in a clear and concise way, and regularly preparing lesson plans that are engaging and incorporate the curriculum
- Incorporate the school's objectives into your curriculum by remaining up to date with mission and initiatives
- Attend staff development opportunities to improve your skills and receive help and feedback from colleagues
- Regularly communicate with parents and legal guardians regarding child's performance, track and record student progress and keep records up to date for progress reports and report card conferences
- Review curriculum needs and execute plans for improvement, and provide tutoring and additional support
- Act as a role model by making your students feel motivated while maintaining an approachable personality
- Be willing to attend some school events to better understand student interest and personalities outside of the regular classroom, build strong relationships with your students and aid in the strengthening of their self-confidence while inspiring them to achieve high goals
- Perform other duties and tasks as assigned

- Must hold or be eligible to obtain a valid Indiana Teaching License
- Must hold or be willing to obtain dual credit certification status, either with Advanced Placement or with 18 hours of Master's level coursework in their content field.
